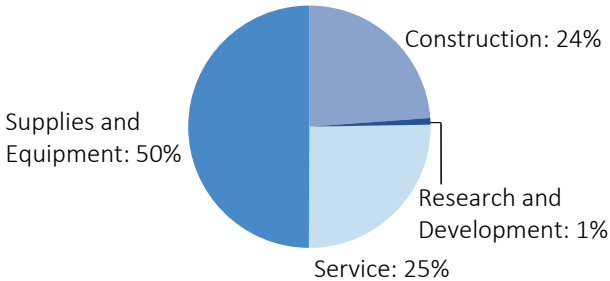

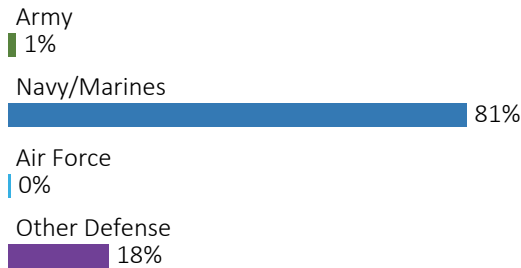

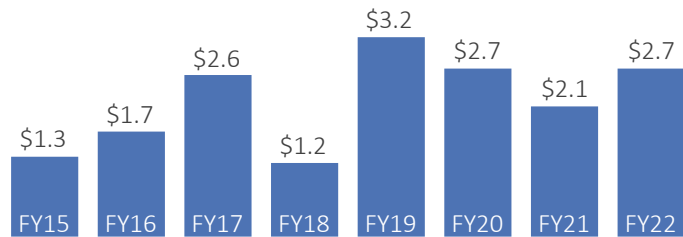

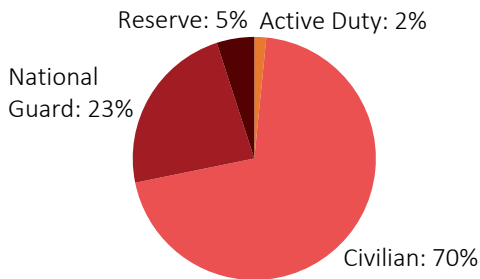
Contract Awards Performed

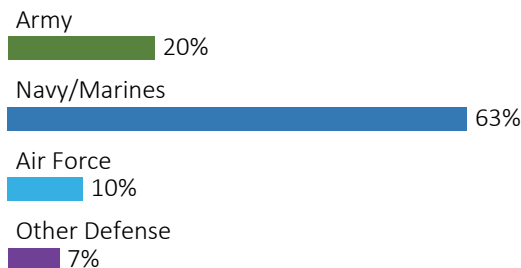
Allocations, By Type

Allocations, By Service



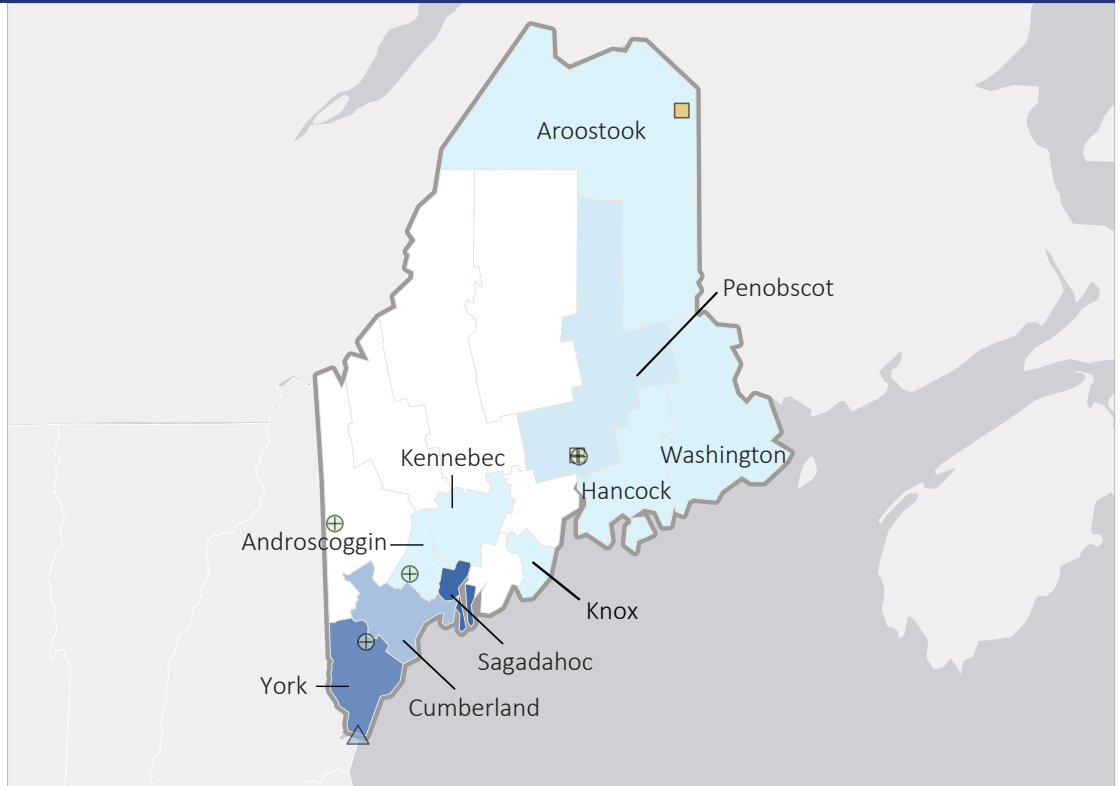

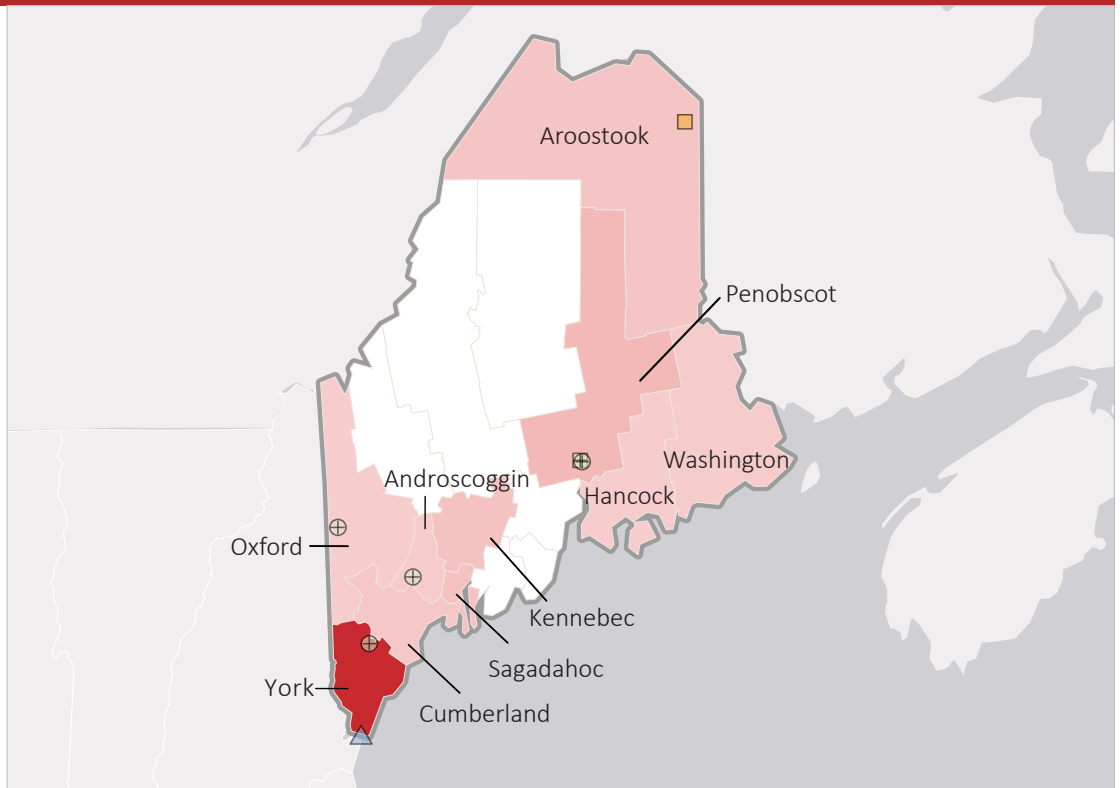
